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## File Menu

The File menu provides commands for creating a new configuration, opening an existing configuration, saving a configuration, and exiting **WaveRave 1.5**.

**New** Create a new, untitled, .WAV configuration.

**Open** Open an existing .WAV configuration.

**Close** Close the current .WAV configuration.

**Save** Save the current configuration if its contents have changed.

**Save As** Save the current configuration under a new name.

**Exit** Exit WaveRave 1.5.

# **Exiting WaveRave**

To exit **WaveRave 1.5**, choose **File|Exit** from the menu.

# **File Close Command**

**File**|**Close** will close the currently active .WAV configuration. If you have made changes to it, **WaveRave 1.5** will ask you if you wish to save the changes.

## **File New Command**

The **File**|**New** command opens a new, untitled .WAV configuration, and makes it the active configuration. **WaveRave 1.5** prompts you to name untitled configurations when they are closed.

If you have made changes to the configuration currently open at the time of selecting **File**| **New**, then **WaveRave 1.5** will ask you if you wish to save your changes first, before closing the configuration and beginning a new one.

If you do not have any configuration open at the time of selection, **WaveRave 1.5** will gray the **File|New** option, and will not allow you to select it.

# **File Open Command**

The **File**|**Open** command displays the **Open a File** dialog box so you can select a configuration file (\*.RAV) to load into **WaveRave 1.5**.

# **File Save Command**

The **File**|**Save** command saves the currently active .WAV configuration to disk. If the configuration is unnamed, the **Save File As** dialog box is displayed so you can name the file, and choose where it is to be saved.

## **File Save As Command**

The **File**|**Save As** command allows you to save the current .WAV configuration under an new name, or in a new location on disk. The command displays the **Save File As** dialog box. You can enter the new file name, including the drive and directory. If you choose an existing file name, you are asked if you want to overwrite the existing file.

# **Playing Wave Files (.WAV)**

To play a wave file press a button with a wave file assigned to it and it will play. You will notice that the .WAV file will play instantly. Even off of CD-ROMs and network drives, or floppies, the access time is very fast.

# **Status lights**



The green LED is used to show that a button has focus, or selection status. The currently selected button is used for the **Edit** menu items **Add**, **Delete**, **Change**, **Colorize**, and **Show Notes**.

The red LED is used to show that the button is currently playing the assigned .WAV file. The red LED will turn off when it is done playing the sound.

## What does WaveRave 1.5 do?

**WaveRave 1.5** is a .WAV player, that allows you to assign .<u>WAV files</u> to individual buttons for quick replay. **WaveRave 1.5** will play each file instantly, with no delay caused by loading the file information into memory. Therefor, you are only limited by disk space in how long of a .WAV file you select to play. Most other .WAV players have limits in this area.

## **Example Uses of WaveRave 1.5**

#### **About .WAV files**

A .WAV file is a digital representation of sound. This digital representation is done in the same manner as an Audio Compact Disk player. The sound is sampled and converted to a value (usually 8 or 16 bits in size). This value is then stored in the .WAV file.

To play the .WAV file, the stored value is sent out through hardware (i.e., the sound card) that modulates the sound card with the digital value and recreates an approximation of the original sound.

The .WAV file is stored in the RIFF format. This format can have many pieces of information, such as the sample rate and number of channels, the digital data of the wave file. etc. Other information can include the Artist, Copyright, Comment and Engineer. High quality .WAV files and .WAV players will support reading this set of additional information from the RIFF file.

# **Drag/Drop from the File Manager**

A file or a group of files can be opened into **WaveRave 1.5** by dragging the selected file or files from the File Manager, and dropping it/them on the **WaveRave 1.5** Main Matrix Window (which contains all the buttons).

# What is Drag and Drop

Drag and drop is a method of selecting files from a file name server (the Windows File Manager is one such server) and then dragging the files as an icon to a client program. **WaveRave 1.5** is a client program that will accept wave files and then add them to next available button(s).

# How to use Drag and Drop

Select a single file or group of wave files in the file manager. Using the left mouse button, click and hold on one of the selected files icon (next to the file name on the left). Now drag the icon to WaveRave and release the left mouse button. The files will be added to the available buttons.

## **Example Uses of WaveRave**

Sound collectors who scour Online services or collect WAVE files on CD-ROMs find **WaveRave 1.5** useful for sorting through large groups of files to locate a certain sound. For WAVE file creators, the ability of **WaveRave 1.5** to group sounds provides an excellent test and debug environment. **WaveRave 1.5** can be used as a virtual cart machine for radio broadcasting, and a sample commercial is included in the program to demonstrate this use. We have heard from broadcasters using it live in the studio in their laptop. Weve seen it used as a sound-effects unit. And using it to browse large numbers of WAVE files has been a regular use by most **WaveRave 1.5** users.

#### What is Planned for Version 2.0?

We are planning to add a whole list of great new features. These include:

- 1. **DDE Server**. Access sounds from other programs.
- 2. Full support of **Universal Naming Conventions**
- 3. The ability to record new sound .WAV files for a button.
- 4. VU Meters
- 5. Play position indicator (so you can see how far into the .WAV you are).
- 6. On-the-fly mixing. Play several .WAVs at the same time.
- 7. Digital Filtering (**DSP**).
- 8. Note Bar. Display notes about a .WAV file (i.e., last few words in an Ad, etc.).
- 9. Type 2 .WAV support. This is a new, cutting edge method of sound representation.
  - 10. Edit .WAV notes. Things like copyrights, etc. can be added into a .WAV file.

All this and more will be available in version 2.0. Support **WaveRave 1.5** and you will have the best in .WAV tools.

# **DSP**

DSP stands for Digital Signal Processing. This is a method of using software to manipulate signals to shape them. This includes equalization, filters, and other effects.

# **Universal Naming Conventions**

This allows you to access network resources without assigning them to a Drive letter. I.e., \main\_server\work as opposed to sharing \work as F:.

# **DDE Server**

A DDE Server is a program which interfaces using the Dynamic Data Exchange protocol with other programs. This allows the sharing of resources and information between many types of programs.

## **Technical Support**

First, you must be a registered user of WaveRave 1.5 to receive technical support, unless you need help with the installation process.

# Assigning a .WAV file to a button

The easiest way to assign a wave file to a button is to use the **EDIT**|**ADD** menu item or just press the **Insert** key.

At this point you can type in the full path name of the wave file or click the **Browse** button. Once a wave file name is correctly entered, you can press the **Test** button to listen to the wave file before you add it to the button list. If this is the file you want then press the **OK** button. This will assign the wave file to the next available button.

# **The Options Dialog**

The options dialog allows you to change the grid size, by selecting how many columns and rows you want. Selecting a column size of 3 and a row size of 3, for instance, gives you 9 buttons.

Also, you may select whether or not **WaveRave 1.5** will give you audio prompts.

# **Show Notes Dialog**

The Show Notes Dialog displays information that can be stored internally in the .WAV files. These notes may include the artists name, the legal copyright, the engineers that worked on the .WAV file and any other type of comments. More and more .WAV files will support this.

# **The Registration Dialog**

After you have paid your registration and receive your registration key, you will use this dialog to fill in your **name** (exactly as you gave it to us for registration), the **serial number** (which you will receive from us) and the **access key** (which you will also receive from us). Thats it! Once this is done correctly, you will have a fully registered **WaveRave**!

# **Delete**

This allows you to remove a .WAV file from a button.

# Change

This allows you to change the .WAV file from what it is currently, to a new one of your choice.

# Colorize

This feature makes button identification easier. By coloring groups of buttons according to type or other criteria of your choice, you can quickly identify them. This option allows you to pick from all legal colors available to you on your machine under Windows.

#### **About Shareware**

Shareware can be defined as a **try before you buy** market. Over the past years, shareware has grown from an out-of-the-basement market to a large and very reliable software distribution method. It provides users with high quality software at an affordable price. However, to continue this effort, software authors must be supported. ## **How to Register WaveRave**

Green and red LEDs indicate which button is selected and playing. **WaveRave 1.5** can create just a few of these special buttons or fill the screen, at your option.
