First Impression Demonstration Application

Welcome to the First Impression demonstration application. First Impression by VisualTools is a charting component that provides the most complete set of chart types and customization options available. With First Impression, the data in your application comes to life in a way never before possible.

First Impression can be used with VisualBasic, C, Visual C++, Borland C++, and other Windows-based development environments. This demonstration application was created using First Impression in VisualBasic. However, this demonstration is a standalone application and does not require VisualBasic to be loaded on your system.

The demonstration files for First Impression are compressed in the file CHARTS.ZIP.

To install this demonstration application on your system, perform the following steps:

1. Copy the file CHARTS.ZIP to the directory in which you want to install the demonstration application and its associated files.

You may want to create a new directory to contain the files for this application. After you have finished using the demonstration, the application and its associated files can be easily deleted by deleting this directory.

2. From a DOS prompt, enter the command: PKUNZIP CHARTS.ZIP

To launch the demonstration application:

- 1. Return to Windows and launch the File Manager.
- 2. In the File Manager, display the directory containing the First Impression application files that you just decompressed.
- 3. Double click the file CHARTS.EXE

The demonstration application launches and is ready for use. The application allows you to view each of First Impression's chart types in a variety of customized displays. You can also view the powerful First Impression end user interface and the data used to generate the charts
