

## **Purchase of Educational Materials for NatureWatch**

6511.11t - Nominal Value Items for Dissemination of Program Information. Funds available to the Forest Service may be used for the purchase of nonmonetary items of nominal value to disseminate program information to private and public individuals and organizations to further Forest Service programs.

1. Authority. The Administrative Provisions for the Forest Service in the current Appropriation Act for the Department of Interior and Related Agencies authorize that:

. . . any appropriations or funds available to the Forest Service may be used to disseminate program information to private and public individuals and organizations through the use of nonmonetary items of nominal value. . .

2. Definitions.

Items of Nominal Value. Items of nominal value are such items as cups, key rings, pins, pens, pencils, hats, and T-shirts inscribed with the program identification.

Nominal Value. Nominal value for nonmonetary items is not to exceed \$25 per item.

Program Information. Information which serves to promote a special emphasis program within the Forest Service, such as the National Forest System Centennial, Rise to the Future, and Animal Inn. This is not limited to national programs.

Public Individuals. This term includes Forest Service employees.
