You don't need emulation software, cables, or special hardware. Mac-In-DOS for DOS and Windows is incredibly easy to install, learn, and use.

Mac-In-DOS allows your personal computer to transfer files in either direction. And text files are translated while being transferred. Spreadsheet, graphics, images, and other types of file formats are transferred as is.

A New Option

With Mac-In-DOS you will be able to use the 3.5" inch high-density floppy disk drive on your DOS-based computer to apply a high-density Macintosh format to a 1.44 MB diskette.
