## ***Introduction***

Hyper Maker HTML 1.3 is an HTML editor that permits to create multimedia publications. It include an setup/visor program for the free distribution (without royalties) of HTML multimedia publications, in diskettes or CD-ROM.

Hyper Maker HTML supports most of the HTML 2.0 tags and several of the most useful HTML 3 enhancements:

- Inline images (bitmap, GIF, and JPEG)
- HTML Tables
- HTML Forms
- Default font sizes, styles, and colors
- Background images
- Inline Video
- Background sounds or "soundtracks"
- Inline Audio
- Pop-up Windows
- Encrypted HTML files
- Multipage publications

This package include two programs:

- Hyper Maker HTML 1.3      Editor and publication compiler of HTML files.
- HMViewer 1.3              Read-only viewer & installer for distribute the publications.

## How to Make multipage publications

### A Hyper Maker publication consists on:

An ASCII file, with the PUB extension, which contains the publications files list of HTML pages, and its visualization options.

One or several HTML files, that forms the pages or articles of the publication.

Any number of images, videos and sounds.

The viewer program: HMViewer.EXE.

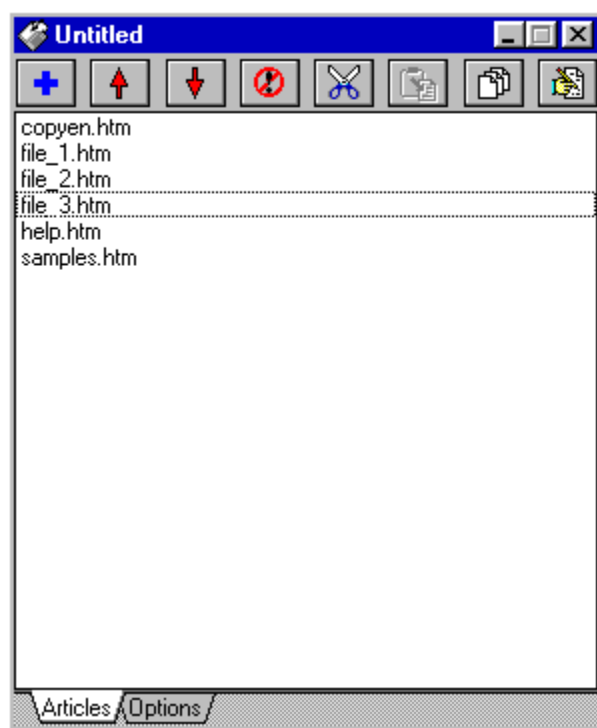


To create a publication is accurate that all the files who composes it should be found within the same directory.

The *Publication/New* command is intended for arrange the HTML pages of your publications. This command open the *Publication Window*.

### Publication Window

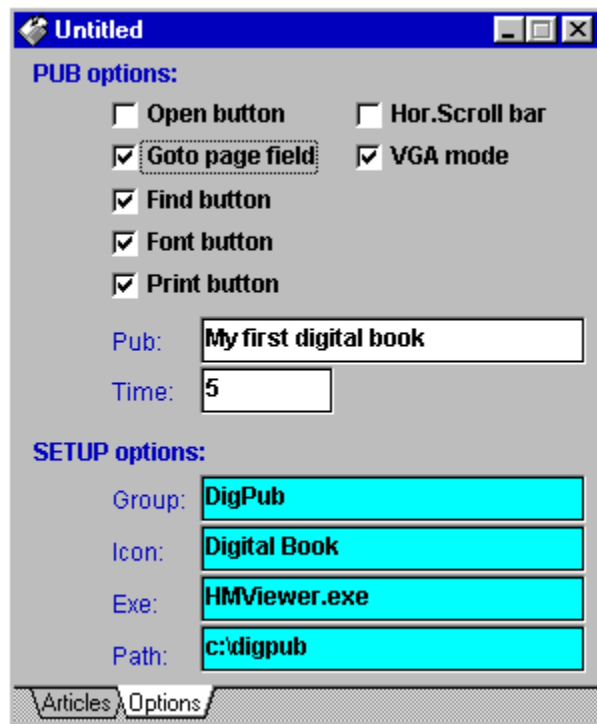
This Windows is separated in two pages:



### Articles

The top toolbar of this page includes buttons for several uses. Make click on the buttons for a brief description of its functions.

The order in which articles (or *pages*) appear in the list box of this page, determines the order in which the HMViewer shows and browse them.



## Options

This page allows the customization of the HMViewer program button bar.

The check boxes present options for the user; the user can check it to select the option, or uncheck it to deselect the option. Make click on the buttons for a brief description of its functions.

## ***How to Distribute Publications***

The *Publication/Copy files* command, encrypts and copy all the publication files, and the Setup program in a temporary directory.

The ***Options*** page, of *Window Publication* , let you specify the options for install your publication.

After copy the files into a temporary directory, you got to copy them at diskette or CD-ROM.

### HTML Forms

Full supported.

The AVI file will be scaled to the specified width and height, and then positioned according left and top values.

## **SOUNDS**

The BGSOUND tag allows you to create pages with background sounds or "soundtracks." Sounds can either be WAV (WAV format) or MIDI (MID format). The HTML tag used to insert a background sound into a page is:

```
< BGSOUND SRC="start.wav" >
```

Another option:

```
< BGSOUND SRC="start.wav" LOOP=INFINITE >
```

This tag must be placed within the first 20 lines of the HTML file. Another option for playing sounds is:<P>

```
<A HREF="start.wav">Play start</A >
```

```
<A HREF="op23.mid">Play op23</A >
```

The LOOP attribute is not applied here.

```
<A HREF="left, top, width, height, MyMovie.AVI">Ply MyMovie>
```

The AVI file will be scaled to the specified width and height, and positioned according left and top values.



## About Viewer Module

### Applications

The HMViewer enables you to distribute your HTML files as multipage publications.

It can be used to distribute:

- Catalogues
- Books
- Presentations
- Educational material
- Magazines and digital newspapers
- And everything you need

The HMViewer can start executable programs and Windows HELP files, thus making it suitable for tutorials or shareware programs distribution.

This freeware edition of HMViewer has some limitations, but they cannot be found in the professional version:

- It is limited to a maximum of 5 pages.
- It only accepts BMP images (GIF and JPEG available en Pro version).
- It cannot show videos (AVI), nor play sounds.
- It dont support Forms.

### HMViewer interface

The HMViewer interface is quite simple - the buttons at the bottom of the screen allow you to control the basic operations. (see the viewers help for information).



The HMViewer also possesses a pop up menu, that enables you to create new windows, or to accommodate the existing windows, within the screen. These functions are useful when its required a simultaneous several pages view.

The backspace key is also very useful - it allows you to return at the previous page viewed.

The corresponding keys of each button is indicated in the status bar when the cursor moves over any button.

### Registration Benefits:

The registration code will update the visor module (used to distribute the publications). The viewer shareware version has some limitations, which cannot be found in the registered version:

- It is limited to a maximum of 5 pages per publication.
- Only accepts BMP images.
- Not allow hypertext links with pages outside the browse sequence.
- Cannot show videos (AVI), nor play sounds.
- Not support Forms.

Hyper Maker HTML (the editor module) is not limited in any way.

### You can choose different options to be registered

The registration price for the full version is \$ 150 (40+(20\*6))-\$ 10 discount.

Also you can specify those specific items wanted to incorporate in the registered version..

*If at first you request the standard version, and later add any of the options, you will be surcharged \$ 5 to cover the fixed operation expenses.*

**The registered user can distribute freely with their publications the Hyper Maker Visor Module, without paying any royalties.**

### Registration Procedure:

When your order is received, I will send you a telephone number and an address, so you could

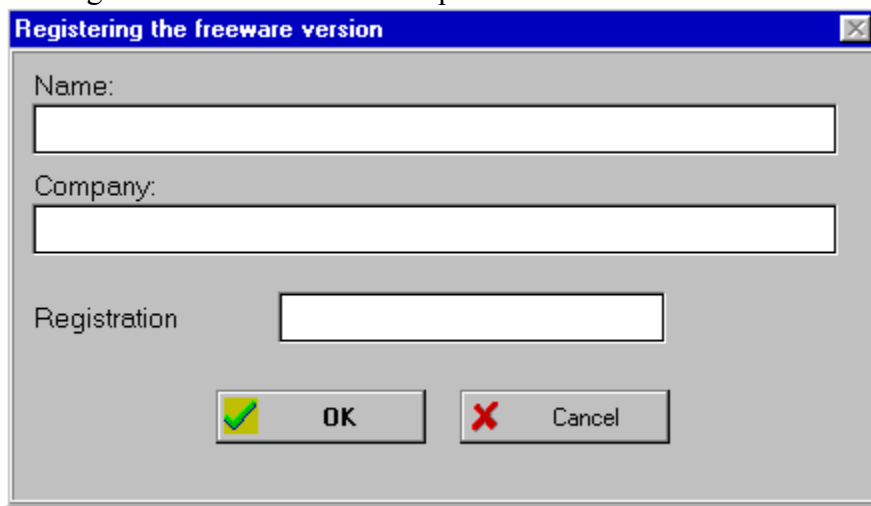
order Hyper Maker through your credit card (MasterCard, Visa, American Express, or Discover), by phone or mail.

The credit card order service will notify me your order, and I will send you the registration code to legally enable the full operation of Hyper Maker.

The registration code that I will send you will be valid only for the name and company that you specify in your order.

To update the freeware version to the registered version of **HMViewer**, click in the *Registering form* command in the *Help* menu.

Download the last version of Hyper Maker HTML from Bersoft's World Wide Web home pages:

Open the selected article in a Window, for editing them.

Paste article(s) in list (used for change the order of the list).

Cut article(s) from the list.

Copy article(s) from the list.



Exclude selected article(s) from the publication list.

Move Up Button: Change the browse order of the selected article(s), by moving them Up.

Change the browse order of the selected article(s), by moving them Down.

Add files to the Publication list.

Publication files list.

Show/hide the open publication button. This button let you open different publications, located in other directory. Wacht out, HMViewer opens automatically the publication when it is named PUB1.PUB and its located in the same directory that the HMViewer.

Show/hide the goto page field. This text field permits the user to write the number of page, and see it.

Show/hide the word searching button.



Show/hide the font button. Change the font size, color and name, and the background color of the HTML page.

Show/hide the Print Button.

Display a horizontal scroll bar in the viewer window.

Lock the viewer window in VGA (640x480) mode.

Name and publication window title.

Time of initial window with logo and company name (0-60 seconds).

Name of the Group that will be created in the Program Manager.

Name of the Icon that will be created in the Program Manager.



File Name of HMViewer (you can modify the default HMVIEWER.EXE name).

Proposed Path for installation of publication files.

JPEG images allows 16.7 millions of colors with minimal disk space wasted.

### Setup program

The HMViewer program includes a Setup module. This program create a Group and an Icon into Program Manager, and copy your files into the hard disk, with the names specified in the *Options* page of *Publication* Windows.
