Please take the time to read this text file. It explains what we at EMC feel about the current CD market and why we decided to develop this CD series.

Firstly, let us take this opportunity to thank you for purchasing this CD. We sincerely hope that you enjoy using it. We would welcome any constructive feedback that you would like to offer us. Unlike some other companies, we actually care what you, our customer, think and feel about our products.

We have seen almost every CD title in existence and sadly, the general trend appears to be "shovel as much data on as possible and to hell with the quality" The majority of the CDs we have seen are developed as multi platform CDs and while this may be advantageous for the company selling them, the end user with his Amiga is faced with a CD containing a high proportion of files that he probably can't even use.

This approach is evidently used by the so called "big boys" in the CD industry. The result... a CD that is CRAP! These CDs are advertised with promises of sheer quality and their titles feature such words as "Professional" "The Best" etc.. How many of you have bought CDs like this? We'll bet that you'll wholeheartedly agree with what we are saying!

We genuinely feel that the current situation stinks and with this series of CDs we at EMC are aiming to set the standards on which all CDs on the Amiga will be judged. A big claim you say? Well folks! the contents and layout of this CD should convince even the most sceptical of you out there!

A Quick word on Shapshotting

We have snapshotted all icons (directory, preview, text etc.) using the default Amiga Topaz 8 font as the font for the Workbench, System & Screen preference settings. If windows and/or icons open up too close together, too far apart or in strange places, it's probably because you are using a non standard font.

System Details

For those of you that are interested, we thought that some of you would like to know the sort of hardware and software that was used to develop these CDs.

Hardware

AMIGA 2000

Fitted with a 40mb (WOW!) hard drive and 1mb of chip ram and 2mb of fast ram and 4 floppy drives. This machine has both kickstart 1.3 and 2.04 roms fitted and was used to mainly for checking software compatibility on WB 1.3.

AMIGA 1200

Fitted with a 540mb Quantum Maverick (very fast) IDE hard drive, 10mb of 32bit ram, a 20mhz CoPro and an external floppy. This machine was/is linked to the 3000 via Parnet and was used for additional storage (?) processing AGA data and as a second machine for creating the IFF thumbnails on this CD and creating the text files

AMIGA 3000

This machine was at the heart of the CD development. Internally this machine is fitted with a Seagate 1.2 Gb SCSI2 hard drive, WB 3.1, 30mb of ram, Opalvision, Cybervision 64 4mb graphics card, a Multiface2 card, a high density floppy drive and a Mercury 040 accelerator running at 28mhz (22 Mips) A PC (God I hate them!) tower case was used to house additional scsi devices. These included a 4.3 gigabyte Quantum GrandPrix SCSI2 hard drive, a Toshiba double speed CDRom, a 128mb Fujitsu Magneto Optical drive, a 250mb Archive Viper tape streamer and a 16 gigabyte Sony DDS2 DAT backup tape drive.

This is the largest directory on the CD and contains all the backgrounds. The three main directories contain the images in JPEG 800x600 24bit, PAL 768x576 256 colour IFF and NTSC 768x480 256 IFF colour formats.

Please note that the 256 colour versions of the image backgrounds all have offset 248 colour palettes. This will enable you to use/adjust the first 8 colours (colours 0-7) to any colour you need within your presentation.

Nice touch eh!

PS The thumbnail indexes on this CD use Multiview as their default viewer. If you have any trouble viewing the Backgrounds' Index files...Please refer to the program "ToolAlias" in the Utilities directory, as this allows you to change the default picture viewer.

- Anims This directory contains several counter animations. These animations are really useful and can add that "Professional Touch" when used at the beginning of either presentations or videos.
- DataTypes This directory contains a selection of popular Datatypes for Workbench 3+ machines.
- Buttons This directory contains loads of button screens containing "Buttons" that can be cut and used in presentations. Simply load the button screen into a paint package and cut the desired buttons out as brushes and save them out. You can then import the ready made buttons into your presentation program ready for use.
- Screens This directory contains setup and test screens. These can be used as you see fit but are really designed to be used for screen centralisation and colour calibration.
- AmigaCD This directory contains a really useful Amigaguide file written by Anders Bakkevold and has been included with his kind permission. 1.10 EMC Phase4 CD... Bitmap fonts installation guide

The Bitmap directory

=====

This directory contains the bitmap fonts. Most of these fonts come in 20 sizes between 18 and 168 point. These fonts are really intended for users of the Scala Multimedia series of programs. The advantage of using bitmap fonts is speed, especially when loading large Scala scripts and creating large point sizes on the pages of your presentation. Since most point sizes have already been created and are available for your use, you will be able to create fast presentations without having to wait around while fonts are being created and/or loaded.

The icon inside each font directory called "AssignFonts" quite simply assigns the new directory of fonts to your system so the new fonts will be available to you. This is NOT permanent and if you reboot you will have to double click on the icon again to reassign the fonts.

If you find a font that you would like to install on your system permanently, load up a directory utility, such as Directory Opus, SID or DirWorks, and simply copy the font's directory AND the directory's' .FONT file to your system's font directory.

For example: If you would like to install a font called "ReallyCool" to your system, copy the "ReallyCool" font directory and the "ReallyCool.font" file from the bitmap font directory on the Phase 4 CD to your Fonts: directory on your hard drive. Once you have done this, be sure to run the Workbench program "Fixfonts" which should be located on your boot partition in the "System" drawer.

Please note: The bitmap font directories also contain the standard 5 and 8 point Deluxe Paint font. Since Deluxe Paint needs it's own font to run the inclusion of this font should eliminate any potential problems for Deluxe Paint users after they have reassigned the fonts directory.

The font was included on this CD with the kind permission of Electronic Arts who hold the trademark on the Deluxe Paint series of graphics programs.

1.11 EMC Phase4 CD... Intellifont installation guide

The Intellifont directory

=====

This directory contains workbench scalable fonts. For the sake of simplicity we have put each individual font (and its associated files) into their own separate directories. In each directory you will also find an icon called "InstallFont", when you double click on this icon the CG scalable font will be installed into your system for you. Please wait for all disk activity to finish before running an application.

Once the font has been installed you will be able to load your application, open the application's font requester and select the font you have just installed. You will be presented with the font in various sizes.

If you want to use the font in a size that is not available, for example 110 pt, all you need to do is type in the new size in the relevant area of the requester.

Please note: Before double clicking on the "InstallFont" icon make sure that you have the workbench program "Fixfonts" in your "System" directory. You should also check that you have enough free space on your system. On average you will need anything up to 200K per font.
