

**Proximal Attachments**

**Iliocostalis cervicis** arises from the angles of the third to sixth ribs, medial to iliocostalis thoracis.

**Distal Attachments**

It passes superiorly and medially to the posterior tubercles of the **transverse processes of C4 to C6**.

**Nerve Supply**

Iliocostalis cervicis is supplied by the dorsal rami of C4 to T6.

**Action**

When working on one side only it produces lateral flexion and some extension. When both sides are working they extend the neck.
