## **Proximal Attachments**

Iliocostalis cervicis arises from the angles of the third to sixth ribs, medial to iliocostalis thoracis.

## **Distal Attachments**

It passes superiorly and medially to the posterior tubercles of the transverse processes of C4 to C6.

## **Nerve Supply**

Iliocostalis cervicis is supplied by the dorsal rami of C4 to T6.

## Action

When working on one side only it produces lateral flexion and some extension. When both sides are working they extend the neck.
