Vertical intermediate is one of the three parts of longus colli.

Proximal Attachment

The vertical intermediate part of longus colli arises from the anterior aspect of the bodies of C5 to T3.

Distal Attachment

It passes superiorly to attach to the anterior aspect of the bodies of C2 to C4.

Nerve Supply

It is supplied by the anterior rami of C2 to C6.

Action

The vertical intermediate part of longus colli flexes the neck.
