

The fourth sacral dorsal rami, which are smaller than the dorsal rami above, exit the sacral canal through the fourth dorsal sacral foramina between the fused fourth and fifth sacral vertebrae, below multifidus. They join with the dorsal rami of S5 and the Co1 to form loops on the dorsum of the sacrum, from which branches arise to supply skin over the coccyx.
