Learning How to Browse

The **Learn** tab works just like an internet browser. You'll find this tab fast and easy to learn. And like the world wide web, you'll find this section of the program packed with information on quilting.

- 1 To start browsing, click the **Learn** tab.
- 2 Click on any link in the palette on the right.

You can see whether an item on a page is a link by moving the mouse pointer over the item. If the pointer changes to a hand, the item is a link. A link can be a picture, a 3-D image, or colored text.

The tools on the main toolbar help you browse. Here's how they work:

To return to the last page you viewed, click the **Back** button.

To view a page you viewed before clicking the **Back** button, click the **Forward** button.

If a page you are trying to view is taking too long to open, click the **Stop** button.

If you get a message that a web page cannot be displayed, or you want to make sure you have the latest version of the page, click the **Refresh** button.

The homepage for your internet browser appears when you click the **Home** button.

Click **Search** to display a list of search providers. You will need to be connected to the internet to view these pages.

To select a page from our list of the best, click the **Best** button. The first set of pages are links to pages in the program. The second set of pages are links to web pages. You'll need to be connected to the internet to view these pages.

To print the main page, click anywhere on the page. Click the **Print** tool.

Returns to the last page viewed.

Stops loading the page.



Refreshes the page.



Returns to the homepage set in your internet browser.



Displays a list of internet search providers.



Displays a page from our list of the best pages.



Prints the current page.


Learning How to Search

You can find information on the web in a variety of ways.

Click the **Search** button on the toolbar to gain access to a number of search providers. Click on one of the names in the list. Then on the main search page for the provider you've selected, type a word or phrase that describes what you're looking for. When your search results appear, you can view the individual web pages without losing your list of search results. Click the **Back** button to return to the search results page.
