

Read ^{with} Me Bible

An NIV Story Bible for Children

Ages 5 to 10



Hints

- Click the Bible story pictures to find pop-up surprises.
- Click the bird, horse, letters, or puzzle piece below the stage to start activities.
- Click the banner on the left column to see table of contents and scores.
- Click on the blue scroll beneath the stage to display the text.
- Click on words to hear them pronounced. Click on colored words to hear them defined.
- Click on the top of the pillar labeled "Help" for audio help for the current activity.
- Click on the arrows on pillars to move forward or back.
- Click on the Read statue to have the story read.
- Click on the Music statue to play music so you can read along.
- Click on "Exit" to leave the program.

Installation

- Insert the CD-ROM into your disk drive.
- From the Program Manager screen select File Run (a dialog box will be presented).
- Type "x:\SETUP" without the quotes, and substitute the letter of your CD-ROM drive for "x".
- Select "OK".

The setup program creates a Program Group and an icon to start the program. The files installed on your hard drive require less than 1K of space.

Windows 95 and 98:

- Select the Start Menu button and choose Run.
- Type "x:\SETUP" without the quotes, and substitute the letter of your CD-ROM drive for "x".
- Select "OK".



System Requirements

This program runs on any system that supports MPC 2. Specifically, this requires the following:

- SVGA video: 256 colors in 640x480 mode or better (Local bus video strongly recommended)
- 4MB RAM w/ Virtual Memory set to 4096K or higher
- DOS 4.0 or above
- Windows 3.1 or above
- Sound Card
- Mouse
- Double Speed CD-ROM (capable of 300K/sec throughput)

Troubleshooting

- If colors look strange, make certain your video driver is set to 256 colors (you do this in Windows Control Panel).
- If sounds skip, make certain you have an MPC 2 compatible CD-ROM drive.
