Important Key combinations

The "m" key will display the map, you can then move directly to any marked place on the map. The "q" key will quit the Voodoo Lounge. Pressing control and "q" will let you exit the Voodoo Lounge immediately.

Disk Space: You must have 9 megabytes of free hard disk space to install the Voodoo Lounge Interactive CD ROM.

Install:

- 1. Insert Voodoo Lounge CD-ROM into CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Open File Manager.
- 3. Select your CD-ROM drive.
- 4. Double click on **setup.exe**.
- 5. Follow the on-screen instruction to complete installation.

or...

- 1. Insert Voodoo Lounge CD-ROM into CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Choose Run from the file menu in the Program Manager.
- 3. In the command line box, type the drive letter for the CD-ROM drive followed by ":\setup" (i.e. d:\setup)
- 4. Follow the on-screen instruction to complete installation.

Uninstall:

- 1. Insert Voodoo Lounge CD-ROM into CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Open File Manager.
- 3. Select your CD-ROM drive.
- 4. Double click on **setup.exe**.
- 5. Click on Remove Voodoo Lounge and then click OK.

or..

- 1. Insert Voodoo Lounge CD-ROM into CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Choose Run from the file menu in the Program Manager.
- 3. In the command line box, type the drive letter for the CD-ROM drive followed by ":\setup" (i.e. d:\setup)
- 4. Click on Remove Voodoo Lounge and then click OK.

Quicktime™: We will install Quicktime™ version 2.0.3. The installer will allow you to install version 2.0.3 if required.

Display: The Voodoo Lounge will look its best in 16 bit (thousands of colors) display mode. If you are experiencing very slow performance or very jerky video motion, you may want to set your display color depth to 256 colors. If you are unsure how to do this, please refer to your PC Manufacturer's user manual.

Memory: The Voodoo Lounge requires at least 8 megabytes of RAM to run. It will run much better with more.

Swap File: The Voodoo Lounge will run best with a permanent swap file set to less than 2 megabytes. If you are unsure of how to check this, please consult your Windows™ Manual.

Trouble Shooting:

1. If you experience black spaces on the screen or sound drop out, try rebooting your computer to free up more memory.

2. If you experience other problems with sound or colors while in the Voodoo Lounge, please check your display and/or sound drivers. Some older versions of these drivers can cause problems. Manufacturers have their drivers available for free on line in all the popular online services.
