## **National Debt Reduction Fund**

Additionally, customers purcahsing Vitesse products from retailers or through mail order may send the package UPC card (bar code) and a copy of their receipt to Vitesse, Inc. - National Debt Reduction Fund - P.O. Box 929 - La Puente, CA 91747-0929. For each UPC received, Vitesse will pay a rebate to the U.S. Government. All purchase rebates and 10% contributions will be paid to the Bureau of the Public Debt for the specific purpose of reducing our national debt. Rebate and contribution payments to the Bereau of the Public Debt will range between a minimum of \$1.50 and \$30.00 for each item purchased, depending on the purchase price.

Jim Carson stated, "I believe that Americans as a whole want what is best for our country. Almost everyone is willing to bear his or her part of the hardship ahead. The key factor is that some will be able, and should, bear more of the burden."
