CalcTERA

CalcTERA is an easy to use typographical calculator designed to facilitate the computation using typographical units; it does on the fly conversion beetween a large set of measurement units as well as the four standard mathematical operations (+, -, *, /) in any unit.

The supported units are:

pt pica points, 72.27 pica points equals 1 inch

pc picas, 12 pica points

dd didot points, 1157 didots equals 1238 pica points

cc ciceros, 12 didot points

inch inches, 1 inch equals 2.54 centimeters

cm centimeters

mm millimiters

twips twentieth of a PostScript point: 1440 twips equals to 1 inch; a

conventional unit used by Windows drivers

bp PostScript points (Big Points), 1 bp equals to 1/72 of an inch

Picas (and ciceros) are displayed using the form

<picas>.<points>.<fraction of points>

e.g.

1.6.5

means 1 pica, 6 pica points and 5 tenths of a points, i.e. 18.5 points.

Options

Via the Options dialogue you can set up the following program preferences:

Key click check the box if you want to hear the typical keyboard click

whenever a button is pressed

Display error messages

check the box if you want to be prompted with an error message box when an error occours (division by zero,

overflow), otherwise an error condition will be indicated by an 'E' appearing in the digits display

Minimize enter the number of minutes and seconds after which

after CalcTERA will go from idle to iconic status

OFF button select the desired action for the OFF button (close CalcTERA or go into

iconic status)

Decimals enter the number of digits you want to be displayed after the decimal

point
