

Installation Guide for JRE Exit 1.1

JRE Exit requires Windows 3.1 and VBRUN200.DLL. VBRUN200.DLL must be accessible via the path, normally it is found in the WINDOWS\SYSTEM directory.

To install JRE Exit, run SETUP.EXE. If you are using a windows shell program other than Program Manager or Norton Desktop, you will have to manually create groups and group items for JRE Exit. We recommend creating a group EXIT. In group EXIT, create three items:

1. Description = Exit Windows
Command Line = *path*\JREEXIT.EXE
Working Directory = *path*
2. Description = Exit Windows, Run BAT
Command Line = *path*\JREXBAT.EXE
Working Directory = *path*
3. Description = Exit Help
Command Line = *path*\JREEXIT.HLP
Working Directory = *path*

NOTE: *path* represents the disk and directory where JRE Exit was installed.

What's New:

Added program JREXBAT. Useful for executing those DOS programs that just won't run from a Window's DOS box.

Modified JREEXIT so BAT files can be specified in the "Execute Program" field when the "Restart Windows w/Program" option is chosen.

OTHER INFORMATION:

JRE Exit is freeware.
