## **Super Group Contents**

Super Group is a utility that allows you to display your Program Manager groups as separate Windows anywhere on your desktop. Super Group also provides 5 different views for listing your groups. This is more views for displaying your groups than any commercial product currently provides. Super Group is **NOT** designed as a shell replacement, instead it is designed as an enhancement for those who continue to use Program Manager and cannot wait for Program Manager to provide these features.

# **Introducing Super Group**

Super Group is designed as a utility enhancement for viewing and accessing your Program Manager groups. Unlike Program Manager, Super Group allows you to view your groups in up to 5 different formats. The different views supported by Super Group are, Icon view, Vertical List view, Multi-Column view, Text view, and a Toolbar view. Super Group also allows you to create multiple Super Group windows for each Program Manager group. With this feature you can configure each Program Manager group with a different view and save its settings to be displayed the same way each time it is displayed. Super Group is so easy and flexible to use, you can create nested groups (groups within groups) within existing Program Manager groups by just selecting an option from the Super Group menu. There is no need to perform this manually.

# Adding a Super Group to a Program Manager Group

Super Group supports passing a group filename to Super Group to automatically load a PM group. This feature allows you to take advantage of creating Super Groups within PM groups to create nested groups (groups within groups). Super Group takes all the complexity out of creating a Super Group within a PM group by creating a new Super Group item within a PM group.

## To add a Super Group to a PM Group:

- 1. From the File menu, select Add to Program Manager.
- 2. Enter the description for the icon. The default description is the current group's description name.
- 3. Select from a group of existing PM groups to add then new Super Group item to.
- 4. Check on the Run Minimized button if you want the Super Group icon to be displayed as an icon when it is initially launched
- 5. Click on the OK button to perform the task. Cancel will abort the task.

Changing the View for a Super Group Window
Super Group supports 5 different views for displaying your groups. The five types of views are: Icon View, Vertical List, Multi-Column List, Text View, and a Toolbar view.

- To select a list view for the current Super Group window:

  1. From the View menu, select the view type to display the group with.
- 2. The selected view type will have a check mark beside it indicating the current view type selected.

# **Creating a New Super Group Window**

Super Group supports multiple Super Group windows within your Windows environment. This allows you to display any number of Super Group windows at any one time. Super Group provides two methods for creating a new Super Group window.

### Method 1:

1. Once a group is displayed, select **New Windo**w from the **Group** menu. A new group window containing the same contents as Super Group will be displayed.

### Method 2:

1. To create a new Super Group window each time a group is selected from the **Group** menu, select the **New Window on Switch**. When this menu item is enabled (checked), the group that is selected from the Group menu is displayed in a new Super Group window instead of the main Super Group window.

# **Displaying a Status Bar**

Super Group provides an optional status bar that is capable of providing context sensitive help for menu items. A brief message of the menu items function is displayed as the menu item is highlighted. The status bar also displays the currently selected program item as you change your selection within the list box. This feature is extremely useful when displaying your group as a toolbar.

# To toggle the status bar on and off:

1. From the View menu, click on the status bar menu item. If the status bar is not displayed it will then be displayed. A check mark will also appear beside the menu item if the status bar is selected on. If the status bar is already displayed, the status bar will then be removed.

# **Hiding the Super Group Main Menu**

Super Group allows you to hide the main menu to give the Super Group a true group window look. Once you have your preferences defined for a particular window you can select this option to give the Super Group window a group window appearance.

# To toggle the Super Group main menu on and off:

1. From the System Menu, select Hide Main Menu

# Launching an Item

Launching an item from a Super Group window is performed just like in Program Manager. This avoids the need to rely on a different access method for launching.

### To launch an item from a Super Group window:

- 1. Select the item to launch.
- 2. From the File menu, select Open, or just press the Enter key after selecting the item to launch. Double-clicking on the selected item will also launch the item.

**HINT:** To launch an item and have the Super Group window closed after the launch has completed, double-click on the item with the right button of your mouse.

# **Minimizing the Super Group Window when Launching**

To have Super Group minimized each time an item is launched from the Super Group window, select the **Minimize On Use** menu item located under the **Group** menu. If this option is enabled, a check mark will appear next to the menu item.

# Selecting a Group to Display in the Super Group Window

Only the **Group** menu from the main Super Group window allows you to select a group to view in the list. All other groups created from the main Super Group windows do not list groups under the **Group** menu. To view a diffent group, from the **Group** menu select the group to display. The group will then be displayed in the list box.

**NOTE:** If the **New Window on Switch** menu is enabled, the selected group will be displayed in a new window instead of the main Super Group window.

# Sorting Items in a Super Group Window

Super Group allows you to sort the Program items either by their order as displayed in Program Manager or by their description titles.

To select the sort option for the Super Group window, click on the **View** menu to display the sort options. Click on the menu associated with the sort preference that you desire. The selected sort option then becomes the active sort. The active sort can also be determined by noticing which sort menu item is checked.

# **Switching to Program Manager**

This feature is only available if Program Manager is running. If Program Manager is not running, the menu item will be grayed out.

- To switch to Program Manager:

  1. From the File menu, click on the Goto Program Manager menu item.
- 2. Program Manager is then displayed.

HINT: If the status bar is displayed, you can also goto Program Manager by double-clicking with your mouse on the status bar.

# Viewing Properties for an Item

You can view the associated properties of an item from Super Group without having to switch back to Program Manager. Although, this information is displayed as read-only. This means that you cannot change it from within Super Group.

# To display the properties of a selected item:

1. From the File menu, click on the Properties menu item to display the Properties dialog.

**HINT:** The properties dialog can also be displayed by selecting Alt-Enter from the keyboard.

# File Menu

File operations for launching programs, viewing properties, switching to Program Manager, or adding Super Groups to Program Manager groups.

File Open Menu Launches the currently selected file

**File Properties Menu**Displays a list box that shows the properties associated with a particular file.

**File Goto Program Manager Menu**Switch directly to the Program Manager window from Super Group with the click of a menu item. This menu item is disabled if Program Manager is not running.

**File Add to Program Manager Menu**Displays a dialog that allows you to create Super Groups within Program Manager groups. This menu item is disabled if Program Manager is not running.

# File Exit Menu

Exits the Super Group Window

# View Menu

View operations for setting the type of view, sort, and status bar preference

# View Icon View Menu

Select this menu item to display the group items as a standard icon list

**View Vertical List View Menu**Select this menu item to display the group items as a vertical listing

**View MultiCol List View Menu**Select this menu item to display the group items as a multiple column listing

# **View Text View Menu**

Select this menu item to display the group items as a vertical list of their Program description name

**View Toolbar View Menu**Select this menu item to display the group items as a toolbar

**View Sort by Order Menu**Select this menu item to sort the group items by their ordering specified in the Program Manger group item.

**View Sort by Title Menu**Select this menu item to sort the group items by program name in alphabetic order.

**View Status Bar Menu**Select this menu item to toggle the visible state of the status bar on and off.

**Help Menu**Displays help related topics for Super Group

**Help Contents Menu**Display the main help contents for Super Group

**Help Search for Help On Menu**Displays the search dialog to search for a topic based on a keyword

**Help About Menu**Displays information related to the program

**Group Menu**Select a Group to display, create another Super Group, or set some Group menu preferences.

**Group Refresh Group Menu**Select this menu to automatically reread the Super Group. This is beneficial after adding items to Program Manager.

**Group New Window Menu**Creates another Super Group Window containing the current group displayed in the main Super Group Window

**Group Minimize on Use Menu**Minimizes the Super Group window to an icon after launching an item

**Group New Window on Switch Menu**When this option is selected, a new Super Group is created each time a new Program Manager group is selected to be displayed.

**Group Program Manager Group Menu**Display the selected Program Manager group

**Group More Groups Menu**Display the more groups dialog to access any Program Manager group from a list box.

**System Menu**Displays the Windows system menu

# Size Menu

Allows you to size the Super Group Window with the use of the keyboard

# Move Menu

Allows you to move the Super Group Window with the use of the keyboard

# Minimize Menu

Minimizes the Super Group Window to an icon

# Maximize Menu

Maximizes the size of the Super Group Window to fill the entire desktop

# Close Menu

Quits the Super Group Window

# **Restore Menu**

Restores the Super Group's Window to its normal position

# Switch To Menu

Displays the Task Manager utility

# Hide Menu

Toggles the display state of Super Group's main menu
