Installation

You've already unzipped the distribution file, that's all there is to it. You might want to save a little disk space (truely the final frontier) by moving the two .VBX files to your Windows/System directory, usually C:\WINDOWS\SYSTEM. If a file with the same name exists, then use the most newest file.

Using StarBar

StarBar practically runs itself. But if you would like some help on how to use the more advanced features, like sound, StarDate calculator, etc, then press the F1 key and up pops help!

Registration

You know you should! It's only \$8 and it'll get rid of the nag screens and allow you access to the StarDate calculator, qualify you for free upgrades down the road, and give you good karma. Follow the directions in the Main Control Panel (to get there, right click on the combadge).

Fixes

Version 3.1 provides the following fixes to Version 3.0:

- --Sound Selector bug fix. If selecting a Wave from the root directory of any drive, two backslashes would be inserted after the colon (eg "C:\\BEAMUP.WAV").
- --Sound Selector bug fix. Unable to remove a sound once one had been assigned.
- --Improved icon
- --Added "Startup Iconized" option to the Main Panel.
