## Win/Login

This program, like my password protect thing that when you click on an icon is to keep the average snoop outta your windows desktop.

THIS REQUIRES VBRUN200.DLL, If you don't know what that is, you probably don't have any business setting up this program.

The way this works is, It actually takes Program Managers place as the shell (so they can't just Alt-Tab their way to another app).

To run this make some user files, Such as this, if you want GUEST to be a user I.D. and 12345678 to be the password then just make a file in your \windows\system dir called GUEST.PWD the first line containing the

password.

heres an example:

C:\>ECHO 12345678 >C:\WINDOWS\SYSTEM\GUEST.PWD

This will make the user file.

You can have as many user files as you want. to change your password just edit the file and put in the new pword.

Then, to install it load up you SYSTEM.INI in a text editor and find the 'shell=' line should look like:

shell=progman.exe

change this line to:

shell=login.exe

## \*\*Note

If you use another shell besides PROGMAN.EXE, (such as Norton Desktop) you need to rename it's EXE file to PROGMAN.EXE, (I think the Norton desktop on is NDW.EXE).

Then, save your system.ini and restart windows, I think you can take it from there.

BTW, Since LOGIN.EXE is your shell to exit windows you can no longer close program manager or N. Desktop to exit windows, you gotta shut them down then hit EXIT on the login screen.
