MIDI JukeBox NT Keys

Use the following keys in MIDI JukeBox NT:

Key(s)	Function
F1	Activates the MIDI JukeBox NT Help system.

MIDI JukeBox NT

MIDI JukeBox NT allows you to select and play multiple MIDI and .WAV files. Files can be selected with the Open command, by using the File Manager's drag-and-drop feature, or by associating files with MIDI JukeBox NT. See <u>Selecting Files</u> for further details.

Files can be played once or in a continuous loop.

MIDI JukeBox requires Microsoft Windows NT, October Beta or later and a compatible MIDI output device. MIDI JukeBox NT supports the SoundBlaster Pro.

Selecting Files

Before files can be played they must be selected. Files can be selected in three different ways:

- 1. Using the Add Songs command.
- 2. Dragging one or more files from the File Manager and dropping them into MIDI JukeBox NT
- 3. If you associate all .MID and/or .WAV files with MIDI JukeBox NT, whenever you double-click such a file in the File Manager, MIDI JukeBox NT will be automatically started with the specified file opened. To associate files with MIDI JukeBox NT, go to the File Manager. Select (single-click) a .MID file, type Alt, F, A. Then enter MIDI JukeBox NT's path in the Associate With box (for example, C:\MIDIJB\MIDIJB.EXE). You can do the same thing for .WAV files also.

The System Menu

Bringing Up the System Menu

If MIDI JukeBox NT is iconified, single click its icon with the mouse. Otherwise, press the Alt key and the spacebar or single click the top left corner of the window with the mouse.

System Menu Commands

Pause

Pauses playing of the current song. When Pause is selected again, playing will resume.

Always on Top

When the "Always on Top" item is checked, MIDI JukeBox NT will always be visible.

Commands

Add Songs

Allows you to select one or more MIDI and/or .WAV files to be played.

Clear

Un-selects all files.

Play

Plays the files starting with the current file. To play a different file at any time, select it with the mouse.

Pause

Pauses playing of the current file. When Pause is selected again, playing will resume.

Next

Stops playing the current file and starts the next one.

Prev.

Stops playing the current file and starts the previous one.

Help (F1)

Activates MIDI JukeBox NT's on-line help system.

About

Gives information about MIDI JukeBox NT.

Exit

Quits the MIDI JukeBox NT program.

Continuous Loop

When this check box is checked, files will be played continuously. When this box is not checked, playing will stop after the last file has been played.
