

The Fantazia Concepts BMP Cleaner

November 1993

General

If you are like me you have directories full of BMP's occupying hard disk space on your system. The BMP Cleaner can help you keep things better organized and help keep the "junk cleaned up". It can also allow you to view lists of BMP files and change Wallpapers with a click of a button.

Setup

1. Copy the file THREEED.VBX (supplied) to your Windows\System directory. This will allow the programs to find it when they are run.
2. Make sure you have a copy of VBRUN300.DLL in your Windows\System directory. The program was written in VB 3.0 and requires this file to run. I have not supplied this file due to its size. A copy can be downloaded from most bulletin boards.
3. Copy the program file BMPCLLEN.EXE to the directory of your choice.
4. Install the program in the Program Manager Group of your choice. Refer to the Windows Manual for details.
5. Double click the program icon to start the program.

Program Operations

BMPCLLEN.EXE - This program allows you to view BMP files one at a time, and you may also copy, delete and move files as you view them. You can view the files in a scrollable window or full screen with a limit based on your screen resolution. An additional feature allows you to make the BMP file you are viewing your present wallpaper. You may choose Centered or Tiled for the display. Note that the operation copies the file to your Windows directory if appropriate. This feature is only available for Windows 3.1 or greater Version. Note that this program also accepts a command line and can be Associated in File Manager.

Warranties

The author (me) assumes no liability for any loss you may associate with the use of this program. I have tested the program on my computer and have experienced no problems, however I do not know what your system is like.
