# **PUBLISHED VITAL RECORDS [BIRTH, MARRIAGE AND DEATHS] OF SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.**

The following is a description of 17 published compilations of church, newspaper and cemetery readings from Somerset County which give Birth and Baptism, Marriages and Deaths in the county. These books represent untold thousands of hours of work by many people over many years. Their efforts are to be commended by all who use them.

There are many other unpublished sources of data. A list by the Meyersdale Library of churches with data gives 34 sources alone. They will amount to many hundreds of bits and pieces of data, and, so, it is very difficult to find a person of interest because of the fragmentation. There are also many hundreds and perhaps thousands of B-M-D events that were either never recorded, or recorded so poorly that they are now lost. Examples show all through the Works Progress Administration [W.P.A.] readings of cemeteries of the 1930s where mention is made of graves unmarked, or marked only by field stones with perhaps initials, and of destroyed tombstones.

The purpose of this set of descriptions was to inter-compare them and to see how they compare with compilations of similar data by myself.

In these 17 books, I estimate there are about 3300 births, 670 marriages, and about 36,000 deaths recorded. The largest of these data sets are in the cemetery records books by Brian Ensley. About 6000 to 7200 deaths are in each of the seven. A book of Rockwood area cemeteries by Linda Marker Simmons, has about 3200 deaths. [This is a recompilation of data done by Dr. E.C. Saylor & the W.P.A. Project in the 1920s & 1930s.] A book of Church Records of Berlin has about 2900 births, 360 marriages, and 100 burials. The Records of Beam's German Reformed Church has 300 births, 4 marriages and 130 deaths. All the others just have bits and pieces. Again, to find an event of interest is difficult, and you'd have to individually search them all. And as will be seen, many of the books have "surname only" indexes, requiring the searcher to do much page turning to find an item of interest.

Another large, and till now, unindexed data set is the **Laurel Messenger** [LM], Journal of the Historical & Genealogical Society of Somerset County, which has many thousands of B-M-D events recorded. I have now [March, 2004] completed indexing those events from the 1694 pages for the 44 years of publication, 1960 through 2003, and have added data from Volumes for 2004 & 2005 as they were published. Four other sources, amounting to less than 9% of the total, were also added to the data extracted from LM. From these, the resulting databases contain: 22,790 birth, 8729 marriage, and 48632 death records as of December, 2005. Further data is being added.

Because of some duplication in various articles, there are less than those numbers of actual single events, but, as can be seen, this database is much larger than any single one of the others reviewed.

This new database is presented in several sorts. The main one is alphabetical throughout, both in surname, and given name, and references the original sources. Several other sorts of the data, such as Input Order, and Numerical, and by Parents, etc., are also included. More data will be added in the coming year(s). This compilation of B-M-D data has been made into a CD-ROM, and copies will be made for interested persons upon request. Copies will also be donated to selected libraries.

Because the 17 books reviewed here are copyrighted, I will not attempt to add any of this data to my compilation, unless permission is granted by the copyright holder(s).

There are **many** identical and similar names. Therefore, we **urge** anyone using the data from my compilation to also **consult the original sources** to confirm and to amplify the data of interest to them. See the description of my compilation at the end of this review.

**Church Records of Berlin, Somerset Co., Pennsylvania (Evangelical Lutheran & Evangelical Reformed (Brothers Valley Twp.)),** E.C. Saylor, & Helen H. Greenberg [1929], 168 pages plus 18 page surname index and 9 page index of witnesses. Closson Press, 1989.

The time span covered in the Saylor & Greenberg book, is 1777 to 1856. The records cover the dates: 1777-1838 on pages 1-85, and 1796-1854 on pages 85-158. There are more than 2850 births recorded. About 360 marriages are recorded, and about 110 burials.

In spite of the similar names, the births & baptism records compiled here are of a different Berlin congregation than those compiled by Jeanne Coleman and published in three articles in **“Laurel Messenger”** in May, August and October, 1990 [LM 31, 2, 406 (1833-1843); LM 31, 3, 418 (1834-1876); LM 31, 4, 430 (1877-1901).]

However, the marriages compiled here [Saylor & Greenberg] do appear in articles from Laurel Messenger.

A few, but not all of the deaths compiled here do appear in articles from Laurel Messenger.

The records appear in chronological order just as they were extracted from the German, and later the English text.

For births, the names of the parents are given, but in the majority of cases, only the father is given. For the mothers, there are no maiden names given. Also given are both the birth date, the baptismal date, and the witnesses.

For marriages, only the bride, groom, the date, and the minister are given.

For burials, the name, the date and the age (usually years, months and days) are given.

Since the index gives only surnames, considerable page turning will be required where there is a common surname

**Births, Marriages & Deaths of Bedford & Somerset Cos., PA 1852-1854**, McFarland, K.T.H., 66 pages plus 25 page index. Closson Press, 1999

The records given here are the result of an attempt by Pennsylvania to get the counties to record the B-M-D data for the counties. As can be seen, compliance was very spotty, and it was abandoned after 1854. The counties finally started recording marriages in 1885 and birth and deaths in 1906. This delay is greatly to be regretted, because where the records do exist, the data is invaluable.

The records are arranged chronologically in order as they were registered in the Courthouse record books.

The book is nicely indexed, giving both Surname and Given Name for all the persons mentioned, including in the births records, those "Other Issue" names of siblings of the indexed person born prior to the birth date of the record.

For births, the parents of the couple, including the mother's maiden name, father's occupation, the place (Twp.), and as mentioned above, the names of other children born to the couple before the indexed date.

For marriages, the parents of the couple, the place (Twp.), as well as the denomination of the minister (or the couple?) are noted.

These records are also published in a series of articles in Laurel Messenger. In my [OLF] Marriage Index, I find that for marriages after #233 as recorded at the courthouse, and listed in McFarland's compilation (Page 50), there are no corresponding listings extracted and published in Laurel Messenger?? Why?? That leaves 47 courthouse marriage records missing from the LM articles??

For Deaths, The place of death, the birth date, the spouse, the cause of death, and burial place are noted.

**Rockwood Area Cemeteries: Black, Middlecreek, Milford, and Upper Turkeyfoot Townships, E.C. Saylor, and the W.P.A , (1930s).** Transcribed by Linda Marker Simmons, Clark Brocht and Betty Landis Arnold. Mechling Associates, 2000. 85 pages plus 4 page surname index.

This book gives the readings of 10 cemeteries in Black, 7 in Middlecreek, 7 in Milford, and 19 in Upper Turkeyfoot Twps. 43 cemeteries in total. About 3200 graves are indexed.

Much of the data given here has appeared in articles in Laurel Messenger. Some of it is also on-line at the Internet site for Somerset Co. Townships. A couple of the small, obscure cemeteries have not before been reported.

There is a nice map which shows the location of the cemeteries indexed here. The cemeteries are listed in no particular order, and the names are given in the random order as they were read.

At the end of the text is an addendum of stones in Laurel cemetery that were missed by the W.P.A.

The data given is what ever can be read from the tombstones, including notes as “son of,” or “daughter of,” “consort of,” etc., also some maiden names, and the death and birth and age data as inscribed on the stones. Also given, where marked are the D.A.R. or S.A.R., etc. markers indicating military service in Revolutionary War, War of 1812, Civil War, etc.

**Cemeteries of: Conemaugh Twp., Somerset Co., PA**, By Brian J. Ensley, Closson Press, 2001. 135 pages plus 9 page surname Index.

The book has a one page introduction, and a one page summary of the history of Conemaugh Township.

This book and the others by Brian Ensley mentioned below are a truly remarkable achievement. To have gone out on his own over so many years and have reread so many cemeteries, then compare them with the W.P.A. readings and also to have added notes on maiden names, etc. is truly wonderful.

The 45 cemeteries in this book were reread and compared with the W.P.A. readings of the 1930s. The now obsolete locations given in the W.P.A compilations have been completely updated. One of the statements made in this and all those by Brian is, "Every attempt was made to be as complete and accurate as possible."

The cemeteries listings are given in alphabetical order, and within each of the cemeteries, the surnames have been alphabetized. Within each surname, the given names have been grouped by families. Maiden names of women are given where known. Other information, such as "son of," "daughter of," "wife of," and military service are also given. The W.P.A. did not record the tombstones of children and infants. Here they have been read and included. Notes of graves not marked, or marked only with field stones are given. There are probably about 6700 persons in the compilation.

The data given is as it appears on the stones, names, dates and ages.

Because the index is of only the surnames, some page turning will be required where there is a common surname. Since the individuals within each cemetery reading are grouped by surname, this is a little less of a problem than it could be..

**Cemetery Records of Cambria and Somerset Counties, PA, Volume I.** By Brian J. Ensley, Closson Press, 1999. 199 pages. There is NO INDEX. The indexes for Volumes I, II, and III are all together in Volume III.

In this book the print is larger than for the Conemaugh cemetery book, and there is more white space per page, so in spite of the greater number of pages, there are only about 6000 graves in the compilation.

This is the first volume of a set of seven volumes with the above title. This is as of Dec. 2005. Further publications are expected. Every thing in the description of the Cemeteries of Conemaugh Township above, applies to these volumes, except the selection of the cemeteries themselves.

There are 24 cemetery readings in Volume I.. Thirteen are of Somerset Co. cemeteries. The cemeteries are listed in alphabetical order by name. The Somerset cemeteries, thus being interspersed with those of Cambria county.

There are 18 cemetery readings in Volume VII. Seventeen are of Somerset Co. cemeteries. There are corrections given for errors found in Volumes I, II, III, IV, VI and VII. The cemeteries are listed in alphabetical order by name. The Somerset cemeteries, thus being interspersed with those of Cambria county. An addition to this book is a Gazetteer of Cambria and Somerset Counties. This give the history of the creation of the Townships and boroughs, as well as the township locations of many place names.

This is the first of a set of five books with the above title. There is a one page introduction.

The text is chronological and consists of the date of each extraction and then the complete text of each item from the newspaper. These books are a major source for these dates for Cambria County and a good secondary source for surrounding counties. There are also items from many distant places where former residents of the county have settled.

In this first volume, the locality index for Somerset County has not been done. A search by myself (OLF) found only three entries for Somerset families. Later volumes, being larger, contain many more. However, the surnames contain many of those familiar to Somerset County.

The names index is of both surname and given name, so is more useful than those indexes with only surname listings. In one of the volumes the author mentions her daughter sorting the 3x5 inch index cards for the books. This is truly a monumental series to have extracted so much data from barely legible microfilm and sorting of the result by hand over so many years!

The clergy names of previous volumes have been combined with the names index and indicated by the surname being in lowercase type.

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**Marriages and Deaths from the Cambria Tribune. Volume 5. 1881-1885.** Patricia W. Collins. 232 pages, 8 page localities index and 44 page names index. Closson Press, 1983, reprint 1991..

Everything mentioned above for volume I applies to this one also, but here the localities index has not been done at all, in the interests of cost and space. A quick search of the book for Somerset County localities was done by this reviewer (OLF) and the list compiled contains 21 marriage entries and 31 death entries. There are undoubtedly more. The clergy names of previous volumes have been combined with the names index and indicated by the surname being in lowercase type. The majority of listings in the early volumes are of 3 to four lines, while in the later volumes, the entries are many times of significant length. The information gleaned here is truly useful for this time when few other resources exist.

In 1982, the compiler of this book obtained photocopies of the original church records from the pastor, and used them to write the book. There is a one page preface. The book consists mainly of the actual church records, the founding, organizing, the communicants, church members & confirmations, election of pastors, deacons, etc., as well as financial records of the church. The time period covered is 1831 to 1916, though there are several gaps in the years, caused by some lost records.

The names index gives both surname and given names.

As to vital records, pages 52 through 59 list 300 baptisms in the years 1844 through 1881. Pages 60-61 list 28 deaths in years 1870-1880. There is then a gap till 1938, and another 130 deaths are listed on pages 61-63 covering the years 1938-1958. Page 61 lists 4 marriages in 1870-1877.

Vital Records (Births, Marriages, and Deaths) are of necessity, lists of names and dates. In the original sources from which these records have been collected, we have noted that for every event for which a date was recorded, there are, perhaps, **ten other events** which are listed, but for which **NO DATE** was recorded, and thus was not abstracted for this collection.

Except for an aborted attempt at recording vital records in the 1852-1854 time period, Pennsylvania did not require official records of Birth, Marriage and Death until 1906, so the principal original early sources are records from churches, cemeteries, courthouses [1852-1854], family histories, and collections of these which have been published in the **“Laurel Messenger”** newsletter of the **Historical and Genealogical Society of Somerset County**, or **similar collections**. This is further explained in the introductions to the respective Birth, Marriage and Death Indexes.

In the **Births Index**, the parents are listed, if they are known. Some births calculated from cemetery records are included in the Births Index, but not all. Be sure to check **both Indexes** for births. Many times the given name of the mother is omitted and even where a given name is recorded, a maiden name is almost never given. If a mother's given name is recorded, but no maiden name, the mother's surname field is filled with the married name. Many times I found myself wishing I could go back in time and ask the recording ministers, “who carried the baby for nine months?” “Doesn't she deserve to be recorded, or recorded more than as just, ‘Wife?’ ”

In the **Marriages Index**, the ministers and witnesses are indexed, where they are known.

In the **Deaths Index**, where possible, the **birth date is calculated**, and also where possible, **women** are indexed under **both maiden and married surnames**. **So be sure to check the Deaths Index for Births and women's married surnames**

**Because of the wide array of sources used, this collection will contain much data on events of the families before and after their residence in Somerset County. Also as noted above, some individuals will be indexed multiple times.**

The data most likely to be recorded is a date of birth or death. The date most likely to be unrecorded is a marriage date. As a semi-educated guess, for every 100 couples, probably less than ten in the Laurel Messenger articles will have a marriage date.

The Tables source field structure was originally set up for Sources which have a Journal Name, a Volume Number, an Issue Number and a Page number. However some of the Sources, notably the Cemetery readings in websites on the internet have only a Source name, and no Volume, Issue or Page number. In these cases, the unneeded fields are filled with the numeral “1”.

The sources have been divided into four categories; “c”, “f”, “h” and “q”. They are indicated in the tables under the heading “T” which stands for TYPE. They are as follows: “c” = Contemporary sources, i.e., original church or bible records, newspapers, cemetery tombstones, etc. “f” = Family history articles. “h” = personal dates mentioned in historical articles. “q” = dates mentioned in notes and queries. Each of these categories will have its own peculiarities and limits of error. Contemporary sources may be more accurate than later ones, but contain less additional data. Family history sources may contain much on additional relationships, but contain more error or abbreviations. Historical articles may be lacking in detail. Query sources may have much less detail, contain estimates, etc.

**Each of the three parts of the compilation has its own introduction. They are all on a single CD-ROM. The tables are printable, and can be searched by computer.**
