Text Ascii Format

The Text Ascii Format used by the Editor is made up of the following text:

- 1) Very First Line, Very First Word Must be: "InterPlay"
   Everything else on first line is skiped
- 2) Each Cd's 1st line Must Starts with:

"Index No:\$" Followed by 8 Digit Hex Number

(Ie. "Index No:\$12345678")

Everything else on line is skiped  $\,\,$  (Including CD No: )

(The 8 digit hex number is the Index number and is used by Interplay to find correct cd)

- 4) 3rn line and next lines are the cd track name After: "nn -" (or the 5th character onwards)
- 5) End of Each Cd is a blank line (No spaces just a Return)
