

Support is provided for installing user utility software to either a network directory or local hard disk drive. Complete uninstall is provided.

Reliable CD Recording Meridian's server software architecture addresses the real-time challenges inherent in recording compact discs over a network. The software manages a large directory staging area on a dedicated hard drive on the file server. The result is a robust system that reliably makes CDs regardless of network traffic or file server load.

Remote Management

Meridian's management software is a friendly Windows-based program providing system administrators with the detailed ability to view and manipulate the network-wide CD-R job queue and maintain logfile history for recorded CD jobs. Users are provided with an interface to select source directories and disc format properties.

Background Operation
CD NetRecord integrates to the
NetWare Queue Management
Services, allowing multiple job
requests to be submitted indepen-

dently from authorized network users. Jobs may be submitted while another job is in process.

Support for Standards CD NetRecord for NetWare integrates with standard NetWare services and device interfaces to provide support for popular SCSI CD-R drives and host adapters. Recorded discs are formatted in the industry-standard crossplatform ISO9660 CD ROM file structure, allowing the finished CDs to be read in millions of desktop and networked CD ROM drives, such as Meridian's CD NetROM™ subsystems. CD-R job creation and network job queue management is supported from Windows 3.x, Windows 95 and Windows NT v4.0 client computers.
