

GroupWise PhoneAccess: Product Details

GroupWiseTM PhoneAccess gives you complete access to your GroupWise Universal Mailbox from a touch-tone telephone (using text-to-speech technology) and adds voice mail as a message type in GroupWise. With GroupWise PhoneAccess, you can access all your telephone and E-mail messages through either the GroupWise graphical user interface or through the GroupWise PhoneAccess telephone user interface.

Features

- Provides access to voice mail, calendar items, and E-mail from a touch-tone telephone
- Enables you to accept and delegate appointments, forward E-mail, and send your messages to a local fax machine from a touch-tone telephone
- Provides access to voice mail from a workstation or laptop computer
- Offers automatic forwarding of any type of GroupWise message, including voice mail, to any telephone number or pager
- Provides personalized greetings
- Supports Caller ID
- Supports waveform audio format files as attachments to GroupWise messages
