

What is the HP STAR Program?

The HP Systems Training and Recognition (STAR) Program is HP's technical certification program for systems engineers (SEs). The program consists of a course curriculum (i.e. a course catalog), and a number of different certification tracks to choose from. Each certification track consists of one or more courses from the curriculum which are required to obtain that particular certification. Each certification provides the SE with a unique set of benefits.

What are the different certifications available?

The HP STAR Program currently offers two different certification tracks to choosefrom: NetServer Technical Professional (NTP) and Network Connectivity Professional (NCP). Each certification track has specific course requirements. Certification may be obtained in one or both of these tracks, in any order.
