Installing Tech Data On-line 2.30 from the BBS

Files: TDODISK1.EXE Size: 1,256,931 TDODISK2.EXE Size: 793,428

These are the installation files for TDOL version 2.30. Before distributing these instructions, verify that the customer is a valid user of TDOL.

- 1. Create 2 directories on your hard drive (Disk1 and Disk2)
- 2. Call the BBS at 813-538-7090 (United States) or 905-795-2358 (Canada)...
- 3. At the "Enter Language #" prompt, type 1 (English) or choose your preferred language and press <Enter>.
- 4. At the "Do you want graphics (Enter)=NO?" prompt, press Y (Graphics) or <Enter> for no graphics.
- 5. At the "What is your First Name?" prompt, type either: TDOLBETA1, TDOLBETA2, TDOLBETA3, or TDOLBETA4
- 6. At the "What is your Last Name?" prompt, press <Enter>.
- 7. At the "Password" prompt, type: **TESTER** and press <Enter> through the "Scan Message Base" prompt.
- 8. At the "TD Online (30) Conference Command" prompt, type **D** (**Download**).
- 9. Download the file TDODISK1.EXE into the DISK1 directory created in step 1
- 10. If you are given a list of protocols, choose the correct one for your software. If not, choose option T (Transfer Protocol) and pick a protocol that your software can use from the list.
 - Windows Terminal program uses XMODEM.CRC, Hyperterminal uses ZMODEM
- 11. Begin the download. When the download is finished, proceed to step 12.
- 12. Repeat steps 8 through 10 to download TDODISK2.EXE into the DISK2 directory created in step 1.
- 13. Type G (Goodbye) at the "TDOLBETA (30) Conference Command" prompt to exit the BBS.
- 14. Run File Manager (or Explorer).
- 15. Go to the directories **DISK1** or **DISK2** and <u>run each executable</u> (by double-clicking) them. The file will explode into a variety of individual files. Please delete the TDODISK1.EXE from the DISK1 directory and the TDODISK2.EXE from the directory DISK2
- 16. Copy all the files in DISK1 directory to a floppy diskette and label it <u>Tech Data On-line Version 2.3 Disk 1.</u>
- 17. Copy all the files in DISK2 directory to a floppy diskette and label it <u>Tech Data On-line Version 2.3 Disk 2.</u>
- 18. Go to Program Manager and choose *File: Run*.
- 19. Put **Disk 1** in your floppy drive.
- 20. Type **A:SETUP** (or **B:SETUP**, whichever is your floppy drive). This will install the program to your hard disk.
- 21. Run Tech Data On-line from Program Manager.
