- The **present simple** is used to talk about **facts** more or less **permanent** and **regular actions** or **events**.
- The **present continuous** is used to describe an **action actually taking place** at the moment when one is speaking.

<u>Example</u>:

Present simple

She works every day from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Present continuous

I'm working on the computer right now.
