

- The **present simple** is used to talk about **facts** more or less **permanent** and **regular actions** or **events**.
- The **present continuous** is used to describe an **action actually taking place** at the moment when one is speaking.

*Example:*

**Present simple**

She **works every day** from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

**Present continuous**

I'm **working** on the computer **right now**.
