

- Der Ausdruck **there is** (Singular) wird im Plural zu **there are**.

Beispiel: **There is** a hole in your pocket.

**There are** many nice flowers in that garden.

- In der **Frageform** steht **there** **nach** dem Verb.

Beispiel: **Is there** a problem?

**Are there** lots of children on the playground?

- Bei der **Verneinung** wird **there is** zu **there isn't** (there is not) und **there are** zu **there aren't** (there are not).

Beispiel: **There isn't** any milk left.

**There aren't** many mistakes in your paper.
