Der Ausdruck there is (Singular) wird im Plural zu there are.

**Beispiel**: **There is** a hole in your pocket. There are many nice flowers in that garden.

In der Frageform steht there nach dem Verb.

Beispiel: Is there a problem?
Are there lots of children on the playground?

Bei der Verneinung wird there is zu there isn't (there is not) und there are zu there aren't (there are not).

<u>Beispiel</u>: **There isn't** any milk left. **There aren't** many mistakes in your paper.
