

- L'expression **there is** (singulier) devient **there are** au pluriel.
Exemple : **There is** a hole in your pocket.
There are many nice flowers in that garden.
- A la **forme interrogative**, **there** se place **après** le verbe.
Exemple : **Is there** a problem?
Are there lots of children on the playground?
- A la **forme négative**, **there is** devient **there isn't** (there is not) et **there are** devient **there aren't** (there are not).
Exemple : **There isn't** any milk left.
There aren't many mistakes in your paper.
