• La expresión **there is** (singular) pasa a ser **there are** en plural.

<u>Ejemplo</u>: There is a hole in your pocket.

There are many nice flowers in that garden.

• En la forma interrogativa, there se coloca después del verbo.

<u>Ejemplo</u>: **Is there** a problem?

Are there lots of children on the playground?

• En la forma negativa, there is pasa a ser there isn't (there is not) y there are pasa a ser there aren't (there are not).

Ejemplo: **There isn't** any milk left.

There aren't many mistakes in your paper.
