• L'expression **there is** (singulier) devient **there are** au pluriel.

<u>Exemple</u>: There is a hole in your pocket.

There are many nice flowers in that garden.

• A la forme interrogative, there se place après le verbe.

<u>Exemple</u>: **Is there** a problem?

**Are there** lots of children on the playground?

• A la forme négative, there is devient there isn't (there is not) et there are devient there aren't (there are not).

<u>Exemple</u>: There isn't any milk left.

There aren't many mistakes in your paper.
