In the 2nd persons of the singular and of the plural, the negative imperative is constructed thus:

do not (or don't) + infinitive without to

Example: Don't touch that.
Don't be silly!

• In polite speech, in the 1st person of the plural, the negative imperative is formed thus:

 $let + us + not + infinitive \ without \ to$

Example: Let's (us) not argue.
