

- In **everyday speech**, in the **1st and 3rd persons**, the **negative imperative** is formed thus:

do not (or **don't**) + **let** + **personal pronoun complement** +
infinitive without to

do not (don't) + **let** + **nominal group** + **infinitive without to**

Example:

Don't let me fall asleep.

Don't let the children do what they want!
