

- We call **question tags** the little **questions** (auxiliary + subject pronoun) that are placed **at the end** of a sentence.
- Usually an **affirmative** sentence is followed by a **negative question tag** and a **negative** sentence by an **affirmative question tag**.

Example: You're British, **aren't you?**

We **can't** go this way, **can we?**

She **won't** take the plane, **will she?**

Note: When there is **no auxiliary** in the first part of the sentence, we use **do** in the tag. Example: He **lives** in Wales, **doesn't he?**
