a state or an action that has begun in the past and that continues into the present.
 <u>Example</u>: I haven't slept since Tuesday!
 She's been pregnant for two months.

<u>Note</u>: When since (sense of time) is followed by a clause, the verb of the clause is in the past simple.

an action that has just been accomplished.
 <u>Example</u>: I've just finished an excellent book.

<u>Note</u>: We never use the <u>present perfect</u> with expressions describing a moment in the past such as "ago", "yesterday"... We use the <u>past simple</u>.
