• The auxiliary have (got) to is followed by the infinitive.

Example: I have to (I've got to) go to the dentist's.

• **Have** is conjugated thus:

I have	We have
You <mark>have</mark>	You have
He / she / it has	They have

Note: Questions and negations are formed with do. Example: Do you have to go this way? I don't have to listen to your stupid advice.
