

### A - Construction of have (got) to

- The auxiliary **have (got) to** is **followed by the infinitive**.

*Example:* I **have to** (I've **got to**) **go** to the dentist's.

- **Have** is conjugated thus:

I **have**                      We **have**  
You **have**                You **have**  
He / she / it **has**        They **have**

**Note:** Questions and negations are formed with **do**.

*Example:* **Do** you **have to** go this way?

I **don't have to** listen to your stupid advice.
