

You had better and **I would rather** have a present or future **meaning** and are followed by **the infinitive without to**.

A - Had better

- **Had better** is used for giving **very firm advice** or an **order**.

Example:

You **had better** tell her the bad news.

- The **negative form** is formed thus:

had better + not + verb in the infinitive.

Example:

You'd (**had**) **better not forget** my birthday.
