You had better and I would rather have a present or future meaning and are followed by the infinitive without to.

A - Had better

• **Had better** is used for giving **very firm advice** or an **order**.

Example: You **had better** tell her the bad news.

• The **negative form** is formed thus:

had better + not + verb in the infinitive.

<u>Example</u>: You'd (had) better not forget my birthday.
