

- The auxiliary **can**, in the **infinitive form**, is **to be able to**.

Example:

It's great **to be able to** speak many languages.

- The **future** of the auxiliary **can** is **will be able to**.

Example:

Don't worry. I'll (will) **be able to** pick you up.

- The **past simple** of the auxiliary **can** is **could**.

Example:

He **could** be very kind sometimes.

I **couldn't** hear anything because of the music.
