Ministry of Justice

The Ministry of Justice is responsible for developing the law and the administrative process with transparency; protecting the rights and liberties of the people; assisting and providing the knowledge of law to the people; protecting, preventing, correcting and rehabilitating drug-addicts; enforcing in civil cases and criminal cases; rehabilitating the offenders.
