This is a great game to use when studying civil rights and woman's suffrage. It covers a variety of topics such as laws, politicians, suffrage and civil rights.

## Civil and Voting Rights Jeopardy:

- 1. Split students into teams of five.
- 2. Give each team a number.
- 3. Randomly draw a team number for that team to choose a category and money amount.
- 4. Click on chosen question.
- 5. Give students thirty seconds to write their answer down on paper or dry erase board.
- 6. When thirty seconds is up, click on the word "answer" below the question to show the students the answer.
- 7. Have teams show their answers and give points accordingly.
- 8. Click on the star at the bottom of the answer page to return to the main page.
- 9. Draw another random number for next team to choose category and money amount.
- 10. Play until all categories are used; add up totals and see which team won.
