

This is a great game to use when studying civil rights and woman's suffrage. It covers a variety of topics such as laws, politicians, suffrage and civil rights.

Civil and Voting Rights Jeopardy:

1. Split students into teams of five.
2. Give each team a number.
3. Randomly draw a team number for that team to choose a category and money amount.
4. Click on chosen question.
5. Give students thirty seconds to write their answer down on paper or dry erase board.
6. When thirty seconds is up, click on the word "answer" below the question to show the students the answer.
7. Have teams show their answers and give points accordingly.
8. Click on the star at the bottom of the answer page to return to the main page.
9. Draw another random number for next team to choose category and money amount.
10. Play until all categories are used; add up totals and see which team won.
