Graphics, Improved Searching, a Hierarchical Display Option and File Exporting Option

The November 1995 edition of Computer Select introduced a new exporting option. Files may now be exported as RTF files. Rich text format will bring color and the Computer Select layout to an onscreen document.

During the past year several other significant new features were added:

<u>InfoGraphics</u> now accompany articles from selected magazines. These graphics duplicate those found in the paper editions of these publications and allow Computer Select to more accurately reproduce the full informational content of the magazine.

Many <u>search dialogs</u> have been revised to make searching quicker and more flexible. A new type of dialog lets you quickly find the items you want in lengthy word wheels.

The Software and Hardware Product Specifications sections now offer the option to view results in a <u>hierarchical form</u>.

InfoGraphics

The November 1994 edition of Computer Select introduced InfoGraphics, graphic illustrations containing valuable information. The InfoGraphics appear with records from selected magazines. Articles from these journals are frequently accompanied by charts, tables, diagrams and screen shots that enhance the understanding of the article by providing additional information, or by illustrating concepts and designs with graphic representations.

Solid informational value and relevance to the article are the primary selection criteria for inclusion in Computer Select. Many of the InfoGraphics contain text and/or captions. They fall into five basic types or categories: business and industry charts; benchmark and performance charts; explanatory diagrams; tables; and screen shots.

InfoGraphics attached to records can be recognized by five distinct icons representing the five types of InfoGraphics. Clicking on the icons opens the graphic. The title of the InfoGraphic accompanies each icon. Most of the icons can be found directly above the text and often there are several icons per record. Some icons are placed alongside the portion of the text that refers to the graphic. The icon will be located in the left margin along side a reference within the text to a chart or diagram. The InfoGraphic can then be opened and examined in much the same way the printed layout would provide graphics on the appropriate page of text.

InfoGraphics are created for selected journals. The journals with InfoGraphics available are: Computer Shopper, InfoWorld, LAN Times, MacWEEK, MacUser, PC/Computing, PC Magazine, PC Week and Windows Sources. The graphics are scaleable and can be printed.

To preview the InfoGraphics, go to the Search screen in the publications section. Click on the Attachments field. The list of available InfoGraphic categories will appear. Select any type and click on search. View any of the retrieved documents, and click on the InfoGraphic icon. It's that easy!

The creators of Computer Select believe that you will find this latest innovation extremely valuable in your search for information. Please feel free to contact the editors and let them know what you think.

Search Dialogs

Several search dialogs have been thoroughly revised in an effort to streamline the searching process. In particular, there have been major revisions to the search dialogs used to select items from word wheels. In addition to making the set of search dialogs more consistent, we have introduced a dramatic new type of search dialog that we call Pick Many Dialogs.

Whenever you type a search term into a Pick Many Dialog, the set of wheel entries displayed is limited to those which contain that string. For example, typing Word for Windows 6 in the Product Name wheel will contract the set of items in the list box so that only those which include each of the terms Word, for, Windows, and 6 anywhere in the wheel entry are available for selection.

Hierarchical Results

We believe that there are more effective ways to present search results to you than a sequential list of document titles. We have added one of these, a hierarchical view, to the Software and Hardware Product Specification sections.

Now, in addition to the sequential list view, a folders view of results is available. Double-clicking on a folder icon in this view reveals all the sub-folders or documents underneath at a narrower level. This offers a much more directed path through the result set to the documents you're after.

Computer Select is proud to announce that full text rights have been secured for eight key computer industry publications. The May edition will feature these journals with full text coverage beginning with March issues. The rights for text granted to us from CMP Publications Inc. include CommunicationsWeek, Computer Reseller News, Computer Retail Week, Electronic Engineering Times, InformationWeek, Network Computing, VARBusiness and Windows Magazine. These publications offer unique industry and product coverage. In the past we have abstracted selected articles. The articles we select will now be both abstracted and available with text. Full text availability improves comprehensiveness and enhances overall coverage of Computer Select. It is the number one request we receive from our subscribers.

In recent months we have added 19 journals to both expand and refine database coverage. We have also added full-text coverage for more than a dozen other journals for which only abstracts were previously available. The selections were made based on a comprehensive review of current Computer Select content, available industry publications, and user surveys. In addition, some journals have been discontinued.

The changes in coverage reflect a greater emphasis on product-specific data, company information, and computer trends in vertical markets. Coverage of the technical and engineering aspects of the industry has been decreased. Full text was not available for most of these technical journals, and their focus on tutorials and illustration-dependent articles did not translate well to the abstract-only format.
