### UNDER THE COVERS CD-ROM

Welcome to Under the Covers. This Read Me file contains information on installing the proper system software required to run this CD-ROM, as well as basic tips on navigating through the disc. You can print these instructions if you desire.

Installation For Windows<sup>tm</sup>:

- 1.) Put your Under the Covers CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive.
- 2.) In Windows 3.1, Go to the Windows 3.1 Program Manager, open the File menu, then choose Run. In Windows 95, click on the Start button, then choose Run.
- 3.) Type the following:

[drive]:\setup

(Note that [drive] is replaced by the letter for your CD-ROM drive. For example, if "d" is the letter for your CD-ROM drive, you would type "d:\setup" then press Enter.)

4.) Follow the instructions that appear on your screen. You will need to restart your computer at the end of the installation process.

Part of the installation process will be an opportunity to install Earthlink Network's Internet software to open an account with them. Use this option if you do not already have an Internet Service Provider and wish to sign up. Everything you need to run Under the Covers will install automatically on your hard drive or is on the CD-ROM itself. In Windows 3.1, you'll see a new Program Group called Under the Covers CD-ROM on your screen. Windows 95 will create a new entry in your Programs list, accessed from the Start button. Inside both you'll see a Under the Covers CD-ROM icon, a Read Me icon, and a Register icon.

Once the installation is complete, double-click on Under the Covers CD-ROM icon in the Program Group called Under the Covers CD-ROM.

Installation For Macintosh<sup>tm</sup> and Power Macintosh<sup>tm</sup>:

- 1.) Put your Under the Covers CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive.
- 2.) Double-click Under the Covers Installer located on the CD-ROM.
- 3.) Follow the installation instructions that appear on your screen.
- 4.) After the installation, your Macintosh may automatically restart (if it has to update your QuickTime extensions). This is normal.

Part of the installation process will be an opportunity to install Earthlink Network's Internet software to open an account with them. Use this option if you do not already have an Internet Service Provider and wish to sign up. Everything you need to run Under the Covers will install automatically on your hard drive or is on the CD-ROM itself.

Once the installation is complete, double-click on Under the Covers icon in the Under the Covers CD-ROM.
