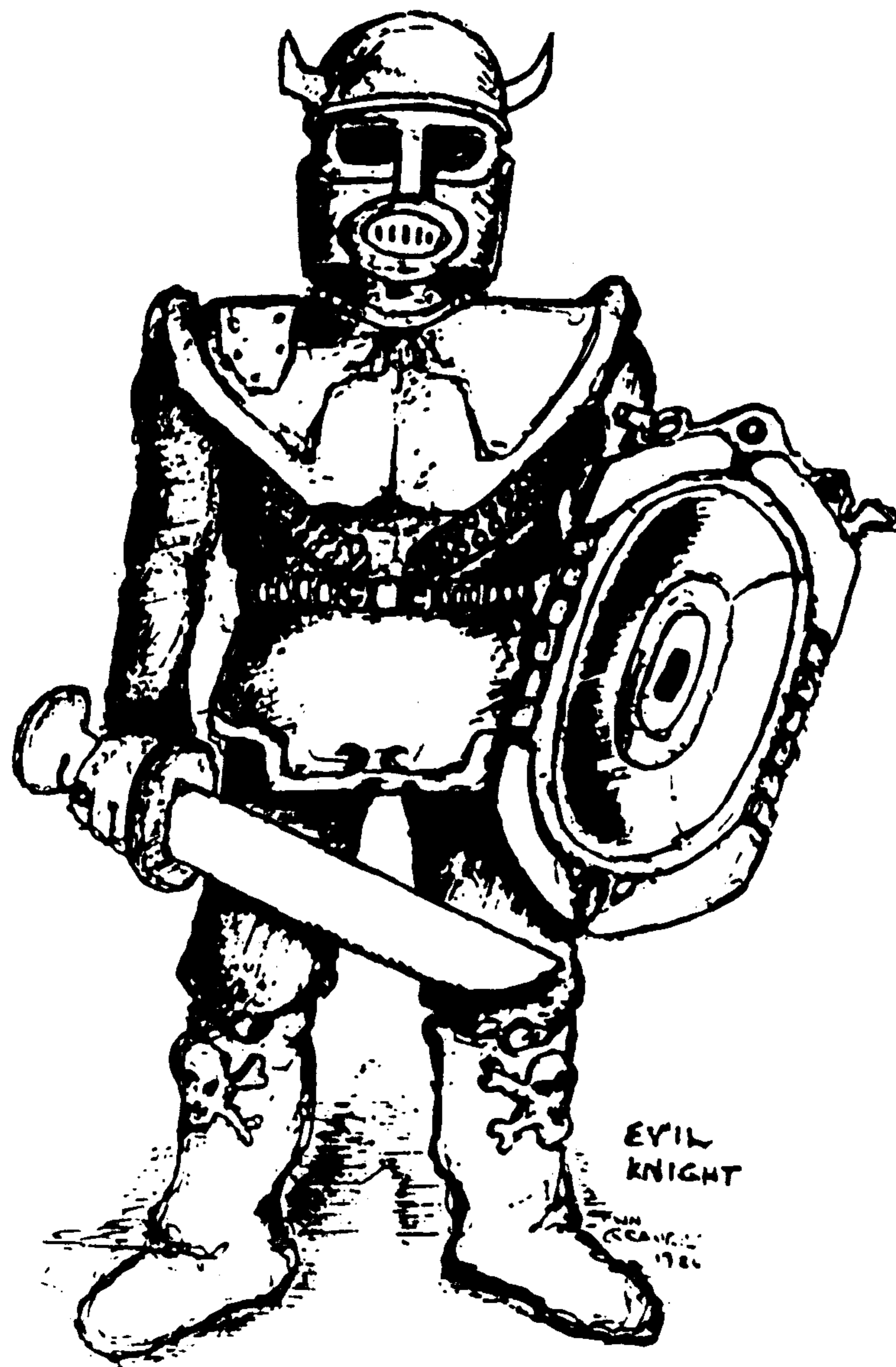

Balloon Wars

This program is a completely original strategy/arcade game that requires both thought and coordination. You must fly your leaky balloon across 20 screens of desert wasteland, avoiding or destroying attackers the while. Carefully balance your supply needs with your situation to reach the oasis. If you fail, well there are others where you came from.

High Gravity

A truly amazing simulation of space! A space station is trapped deep in a solar system with crushing gravity fields. You have to shoot your unguided re-supply capsules to the beleaguered scientists on board, or else. This program is also an excellent teacher of the physics of space flight in general - a vivid aid for the physics student. The new version 2.0 features a solar system editor for creating test situations along with read/save game options. Because all variables are controlled by the user, this is ideal for classrooms as well as just for fun! Written in c99 and compiled to assembly for speed.

Requires: 32K, one disk drive, and either the TI Extended BASIC, Editor/Assembler, TI Writer, or Mini-Memory.

The sequel to the popular adventure "Old Dark Caves", this joint effort of artist Donn Granros and assembly guru Ed Johnson is an incredible advance over other 99/4A adventures!

Written in Assembly and Extended BASIC (though you'd never know it) this two-disk, 170K byte game is an animated, 3D color graphics adventure in the spirit of the popular Ultima (tm) series of games for Apple and IBM computers - only faster and more extensive (believe it or not).

Up to four people can explore a vast island full of inns, teleporters, interesting terrain, and underfed monsters (of course). Cast spells and fight monsters in your quest to gain experience and gold. Then, once you are worthy, explore the six dungeons while avoiding traps, drinking potions, pitfalls, and the inevitable wandering monsters. Not a mere mindless arcade game, you must solve puzzles and communicate with the inhabitants as in complex text adventures by Infocom(tm).

Over a year was spent writing the most complete, satisfying adventure game ever for the TI-99/4A - if you solve it then you really feel like you have done something. There is no rule that a complex adventure can't have outstanding graphics and fast action.

If you know how to use TI-Writer, you can use Font Writer II with little difficulty. Once entered, the program can find all recipes with a given entered keyword in under 15 seconds. Wildcard keyword searches are allowed. Convert the recipe by any factor (for example make a recipe for 4 serve 7), or print it on regular paper or 3 x 5 cards. Menu-driven with menu options in English. EZ-Keys

EZ-Keys is more a programming environment than a programming utility! Once loaded, you can define the screen colors while programming, you gain more control over the editing cursor (including up and down movement through program lines), a true lower-case character set can be used while programming, you can have it automatically save your program every 1 to 18 minutes, and finally, you can define up to 55 keys to contain not only commonly used commands but up to 671 characters of commonly used program code, disk cataloging utilities, keystroke combinations for complicating editing functions, other macro keys (for chaining macros and more complicated definitions) or any combination of key presses you can think of! Even store commonly used code in macro definitions for cut-and-paste between programs.

This all-assembly package is the ultimate tool for anyone that does any Extended BASIC programming - it gives you COMPLETE control over TI Extended BASIC. Also, since it can be used behind other Extended BASIC programs, you can use it with your favorite business programs to speed up virtually all input operations. Highly documented and easy-to-use, you don't have to know any assembly to use all function of this program, and you don't have to know any BASIC to use this program with other programs - all key presses are defined with a powerful macro editor constantly on hand at the touch of a control key.

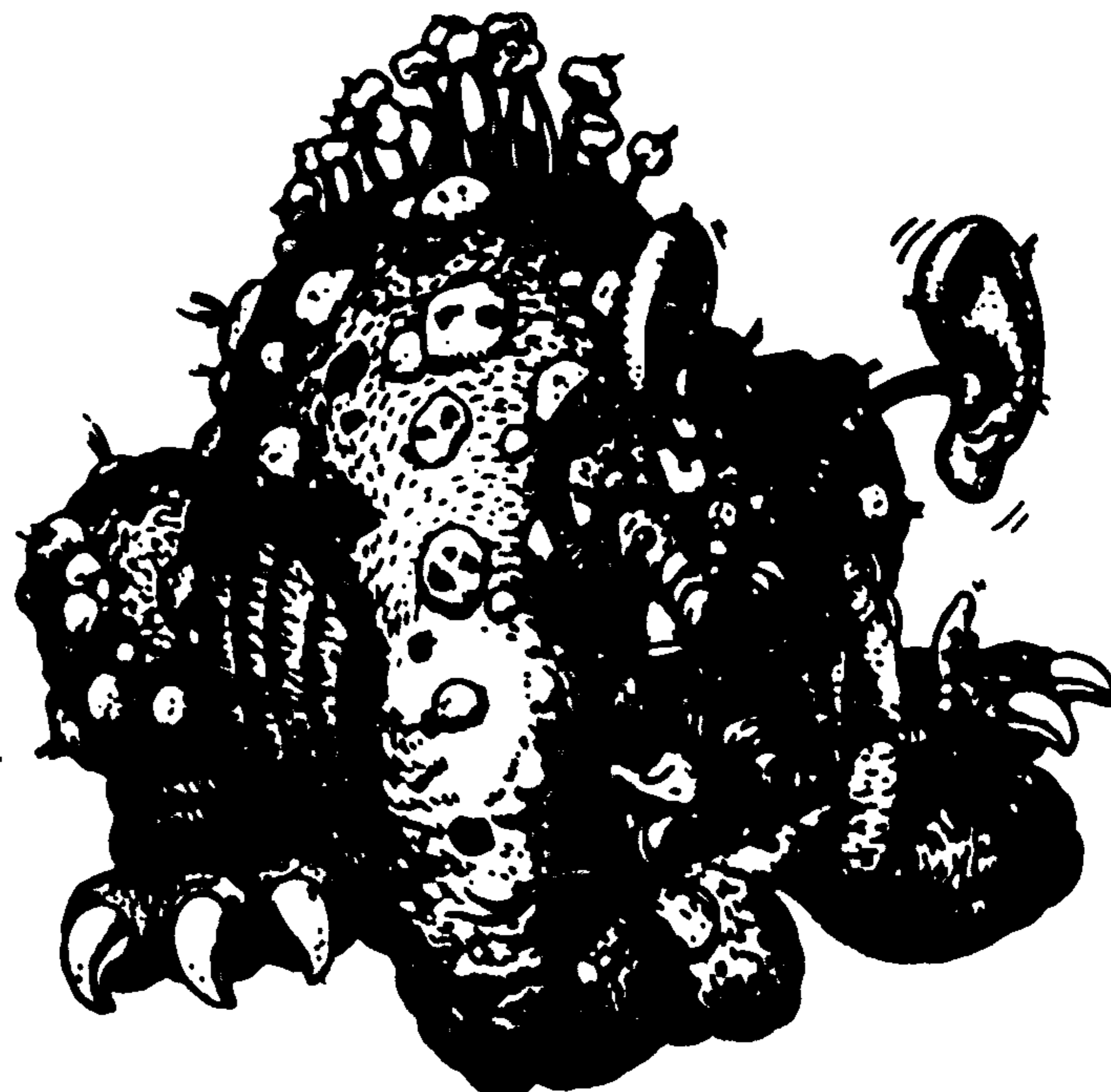
