There are dozens of terminal emulator programs available for the 99/4A and the Geneve. Many of them offer support for multiple emulations or file transfer protocols. Some promise tremendous speed or efficiency. Some offer niceties such as disk managers or text editors. Only one terminal emulator works on a basic 99/4A console, and it won't even allow you to download programs or text files. *Link*, by Jim Reiss, changes all of that. This TE program in a cartridge supports baud rates up to 4800 baud, has a VT-52 emulation built-in, and supports full ASCII and XMODEM transfers to disk and cassette. It even supports a 32K memory expansion if it's available.
